 - o 2 Semesters of either BMS or CPB seminar
 - 2 Semesters of BME seminar
- Fulfill research credits (Must have 90 total credits of coursework and research credits)

Year 1

• Register for a graduate-level ethics class in the first year.

Fall

- Satisfy admission conditions as outlined in your Graduate School admission letter
- Register for Research Fundamentals I Course
- Qual Pre-Registration Form Due (October 31st)
- 1st year IDP Due (October 31st)

Spring

- Register for Research Fundamentals II
 Course
- Qualifying Registration Form Due (February 1st)
- Complete Qualifying Exam (by May 15th)

Summer

Complete online plan of study (by June 1st)

Year 2

- Start thinking about your thesis committee
- Schedule your Prelim for Spring of Year 2 or Fall of Year 3
- Complete 2nd year IDP
- Apply for fellowships
- Ensure that the majority of your course work is be complete by prelim
- Send CV of any committee members outside of Purdue to BME Grad Office at least 30 days prior to Prelim
- 2 Weeks Before Prelim: submit GS form 8, send Prelim documents to committee, send Prelim announcement info to BME Grad Office
- Complete your <u>prelim exam</u> in Spring of Year 2 or Fall of Year 3
- Convene mentoring committee meeting each spring (your prelim can count as your mentoring meeting if completed by spring deadline)

Year 3

- Present your research talk (Grad Student Research Seminar)
- Review your plan of study to ensure all course requirements have been met

Fulfill BME Seminar requirements

Fall

• Complete 3+ year IDP each year

Spring

Schedule and attend annual mentoring committee meeting each year

Prior to Final Semester

- Verify that your plan of study courses match how they appear on your transcript
- Meet with your thesis committee to ensure your readiness for the defense
- Review instructions on scheduling your final exam
- Review Purdue graduation deadlines

Defense

- Schedule Time & Place for Defense
- Send Dissertation to Committee 2 weeks before Defense
- Defend Thesis
- Complete Thesis or Dissertation Deposit by OGSPS deadlines
